


Fig. 2.06 Anonymous, cover, The 'Heathen Chinee' musical album: Containing 15 pieces of the most popular songs, mostly comic. Lithograph. Robert De Witt, New York, 1871. Courtesy of The Huntington Library, San Marino, California.




Fig. 3.02 E. McD. Johnstone, The unique map of California. Lithograph. Dickman-Jones Co., c. 1885. Department of Special Collections, University of California at Los Angeles.




Fig. 3.26 'California Illustrated No. 1, Semi-Tropical Northern California Pictures', *Overland Monthly*, vol. 6, 1889, n. p. Courtesy of The Huntington Library, San Marino, California.






Fig. 3.28 Anaco Brand, Valencias orange label, c. 1910. Courtesy of The Huntington Library, San Marino, California.




Fig. 4.20 Reginald A.




Fig. 5.02 'The International Exhibition, Sydney, 1879–80,' supplement to *Illustrated Sydney News*, January 1880. Chromolithograph. National Library of Australia, Canberra.




Fig. 5.06 'The Pacific Limited: Chicago to California, San Diego Exposition All of 1916', postcard from the Chicago, Milwaukee, St Paul and the Southern Pacific Railways. Courtesy of San Diego Historical Society, San Diego, California. Fig. 6.02 William




Fig. 6.10 'Eucalyptus: California's Mahogany' brochure. Courtesy of Theodore Payne Foundation, Sunland, California. Fig. 6.12 'From

Faithfully your friend, ohn Mun




Fig. 6.21 Santa Barbara Courthouse with eucalypts. Author's photograph.




Fig. 6.29 Franz Geritz,




Fig. 6.32 Guy Rose, Laguna eucalyptus, c. 1917. Oil on canvas, 101.6 x 76.2 cm. Courtesy of Irvine Museum, Irvine, California.




Fig. 7.17 F. Hedley
